



Waddell Elementary **UNIFORM** 2025-2026



TOPS

- Solid green, yellow, white, or gray collared shirts, OR Waddell Spiritwear
- Waddell logo or monogram is acceptable on collared shirts.
- Undergarments should not be worn as outer garments.
- Midriffs must be covered at all times.
- No see-through shirts or blouses.
- No tank tops, spaghetti straps, tube tops, or cut-off tops. Cleavage must be covered.

DRESSES & JUMPERS

- Solid green, yellow, navy, or khaki dresses/jumpers
- A collared shirt or
- Waddell Spiritwear must be worn underneath if wearing a jumper.
- Dresses do not need to have a collar.
- Dresses/jumpers must be no shorter than fingertip length when arms are relaxed at the side - even when wearing leggings underneath.



BOTTOMS

- Khaki or navy bottoms only
- Bottoms must be worn on or above the waist.
- No athletic shorts
- Jeans are allowed on Fridays.
- Leggings may be worn under dresses, skirts, and shorts, but not as pants.
- No belt is required if pants can be worn properly on or above the waist.
- Pants, shorts, or skirts may not have holes/rips above the knee.
- Skirts and shorts must be no shorter than fingertip length when arms are relaxed at the side - even when wearing leggings underneath.

SHOES

- Shoes must be athletic, sturdy, closed-toe, closed-back, and non-slip.
- Slick-bottom shoes are a safety hazard and are not permitted.
- Crocs are NOT allowed.

OTHER

- Jackets, hoodies, & sweatshirts do not have to follow color guidelines.
- Bulky/heavy jackets are not to be worn in the classroom.
- Pajamas may not be worn unless as part of a dress-up day.
- Head coverings such as bandanas, do-rags, sweatbands, or knitted hats are not permitted, except for medical or religious purposes.
- Chains on belts, wallets, or other items with spikes are not allowed.
- Grills or other mouth coverings not prescribed by a dentist or oral surgeon are prohibited.
- Blankets are not allowed in school.
- Attire that could damage school property or cause injury to others (e.g., chains or studded items) is prohibited.

TIPS & TRICKS

- Buy in bulk to save money!
- Sizing up when possible could allow the clothes to last for two school years, leading to only purchasing new uniforms every other year.
- If space allows, it may be helpful to store uniforms in a separate place in the bedroom for easy and quick access.
